ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION

Kaylin's Caring Konnection was birthed out of Kaylin's heart and vision to see all children smile and feel cared for, despite their circumstances. At the age of 10, she was watching a commercial which showed children who had no shoes and the organization was asking for shoe donations, Kaylin was touched so deeply by what she saw. She could never imagine not having shoes to wear and immediately wanted to donate shoes. It was also then that she began thinking of different ways that she could give and have an opportunity to show someone who may not feel loved and cared for that if no one else does, Kaylin Cares. She wanted to be able to bring a smile to the faces of children who may be hurting or facing a difficult time due to being sick and hospitalized. In her efforts to reach this goal, one of her first partnerships was with the Tallahassee Memorial Healthcare Foundation. In 2016, she met with the Foundation's liaison to find out more about the Foundation and to provide her vision and what she wanted to do to give back to hospitalized children. She held her first Christmas Teddy Bear Drive in 2016 and with the help of community partnerships (both business and individuals), Kaylin's Caring Konnection gave over 200 teddy bears to the hospital as comfort to the children. That's a lot of smiles! Since then, the vision has expanded and Kaylin is making a huge impact in her community and abroad with her Caring Drives and most recent, her Youth Care Too! Movement.

Kaylin Jean-Louis is a 18-year-old accomplished Broadcast Journalism Scholar, Motivational Speaker, Youth Caregiver Advocate, Philanthropist, and Radio Personality.

Kaylin is very active in her local church ministry and community. She serves faithfully at her church, Life Changers Church of God in Christ, Inc., where she is currently a member of the Media Team and Collegiate Ministry. She is a 2023 Summa Cum Laude graduate of Tallahassee Community College and Florida State University Schools. Kaylin was named one of the Tallahassee Democrat Class of 2023 "5 Young Women to Watch," and was also the 1st Place Winner in the Business Category for the 2023 World Class Schools of Leon Count Best & Brightest Awards.

In February 2021, Kaylin started the KCK Youth Care Too! Movement to recognize, honor, and celebrate youth, ages 8-18, who are serving as caregivers for sick or disabled parents, siblings, aging relatives, or loved ones. Through the KCK YCT Movement, Kaylin is now leading efforts to advocate for youth caregivers by bringing greater awareness and education relating to youth caregiver needs.

Kaylin's is the host of the "Inspiring Moments with Kaylin" Radio Show, where she brings inspiration, motivation, and the push you need to get you through your day. The show airs on Saturdays at 12 pm, on Hallelujah 95.3 FM.

Kaylin's ultimate life goal is to inspire future generations to unlock their full potential. Her philosophy is simple yet profound: "I don't seek fame; I seek to make a difference." She exudes positivity, hope, and a genuine desire to uplift others. KONNECTIONS & GROWTH

2016

KCK was founded.

- Over 200 teddy bears were given to the local hospital to comfort hospitalized children.
- Over 100 toys were given to children at the Hope House shelter.

2017

- 227 Toys were donated to the Tallahassee Memorial Healthcare Children's Center Treasure Chest, along with onesies and other items for newborns.
- \$180 in gift certificates were donated to the Ronald McDonald House, along with cleaning supplies.

2018

- 30 Gift bags of socks and goodies delivered to residents at Tapestry Senior Living.
- KCK adopted and provided gifts for five (5) teenage girls at a local group home.

2019

Over 300 toys were given to children at the Hope House shelter.

2020

• \$700 was donated to Tallahassee Memorial Foundation for the Healthcare Heros and SuperPup Program.

Youth Care Too! Movement began.

- March \$650 was donated to four (4) youth caregivers.
- **Novembe**r \$100 was donated to two (2) youth caregivers.

2021

- **November** \$1021 was raised and donated to the Alzheimer's Association Walk to End Alzheimer's.
- **December** \$250 Publix gift cards, \$80 Hungry Howie's gift cards, 25 packs of markers, 22 packs of colored pencils, 24 packs of crayons, 8 paint sets, 6 adult coloring books, 8 activity kits, 8 craft houses, 32 nail polish bottles, 10 journals, 2 bath sets, and 4 woodcraft sets donated to the Hang Tough Foundation for Care Packages. In addition, we also adopted three families from the foundation and provided gifts to the children and parents.

- May Awarded \$500 to a deserving youth caregiver.
- **July** 100 backpacks filled with necessities were given to 100 Homeless Persons in our local community.
- July \$100 each given in support of two local back-to-school drives.

2022

- **November** \$930 was raised and donated to the Alzheimer's Association through the Tallahassee Walk to End Alzheimer's.
- **December** Kaylin's Caring Konnection, Inc. & The Ruth Project Girls partnered together and held a Christmas Celebration for the Love Heals Support Group, a trauma healing group for teenage girls who have experienced grief, loss, abuse and other trauma. We served and celebrated over thirty (30) teenage girls.

2023

- **August** Over 100 backpacks filled with necessities were given to over 100 Homeless Persons in our local community. After passing out backpacks, we fed over 30 homeless persons.
- **November** \$215 raised and donated to the Alzheimer's Association through the Tallahassee Walk to End Alzheimer's.

Kaylin knows the value and importance of volunteering and giving back to the community. Through her organization, she has created opportunities for students to volunteer and earn community service hours.

- **July 2022 Backpacks for the Homeless Service Day** 16 student volunteers, 61 hours earned combined
- **November 2022 Tallahassee Walk to End Alzheimer's** 6 student volunteers, 8 hours earned combined
- December 2022 KCK "12 Days of Caring" Holiday Drive & Christmas Celebration 2 student volunteers, 12 hours earned combined
